We are already getting ready for the Spring Gun Show, March 28th and 29th in 2015.

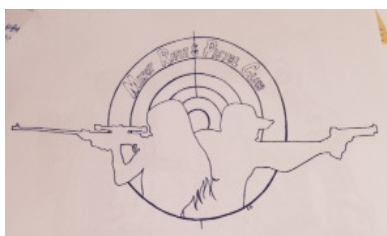

## MRPC Discipline Spotlight

IDPA is an action pistol shooting discipline that focuses on solving simulated “real-world” self defense scenarios. Stages consist of an array of stationary and moving targets, both shoot (hostile) and no-shoot (friendly) targets are used.

The recommended equipment for an IDPA match is a handgun and holster suitable for all-day concealed carry wear, chambered in 9mm or larger, plus additional ammunition carriers such as magazines, speed loaders, or moon clips. IDPA strings of fire are limited to no more than 18

rounds, making the discipline popular with people wishing to compete or practice with a revolver.

Although IDPA is a game like other sports, it has a strong emphasis on the use of tactics such as wearing concealment garments, the proper use of cover, and prioritizing targets.

We host club level IDPA matches regularly, and host classifier matches on a regular basis. New participants are not only welcome, but encouraged. If you are unsure about

how to get started, just come out to a match and see what it is all about; you can even shoot your first match free. Each one of us remembers that we started as a beginner too and are excited to help new IDPA shooters come learn the sport.

The next match is scheduled for Saturday January 3rd at 1:00pm at the indoor range. See you there!
