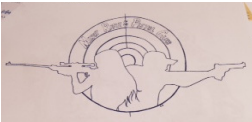

HAPPY NEW YEAR!

Fourth Spring Term for LRSC Police Academy at MRPC

Starting January 20th, the Lake Region State College will be holding their Police Academy spring semester in Minot. The MRPC has allowed the LRSC to use the facilities for the last four years.

The program is a rigorous semester course designed for a career in law enforcement.

The course includes hands-on training of proper weapons handling, crime scene investigation,

emergency vehicle operations, criminal and traffic law fundamentals, and report writing.

Many of the graduates of the program have been assigned to western law enforcement offices. Since the first graduating class of eighteen, the class has grown to at least thirty participants each spring semester.

The MRPC has allowed the LRSC to use the facilities since it is an available space during the day.

The lockers in the hallway in the Indoor Range have been provided by the college for the participants.

We welcome the men and women participating in the program from Lake Region State College to our facilities for the spring semester policy academy.



Reminder: The Outdoor range is still open sunrise to sunset every day while in the winter.

Range Etiquette Reminders for the New Year

- Stay away from the range, or from any gun, if you have been drinking or using drugs.
- Don't interrupt another shooter while they are shooting. Wait to talk until they are reloading or resetting targets. Also do not touch another person's firearm or ammunition.
- Only shoot at your range approved target. Never shoot at another person's target.
- Respect and listen to the Range Safety Officer and ask questions if you have any doubt about what to do.
- "Stop" can be called by anyone if they see something that is unsafe. This will stop all shooting.
- Cease fire is normally called at the end of a shooting period and the firearms should be unloaded and locked open or cylinder/gate open on revolver.

Finally remember the Golden Safety Rules of the National Rifle Association:

1. Always keep your gun pointed in a safe direction.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
3. Do not load the gun until you are ready.
4. Know your target and beyond.

Junior Shooting Program

The Junior Shooting Program is a platform to introduce young shooters to the shooting sports. During the program, participants learn firearms safety and marksmanship. Many juniors from this program have gone on to compete at the state and national level. Several participants have also received college scholarships.

All necessary equipment for

the program is provided by the Minot Rifle and Pistol Club. Equipment includes: firearms (small-bore .22 rifle, air rifle and air pistol), spotting scopes, shooting jackets and gloves, mats, slings, and eye/ear protection.

The program runs Saturday mornings (check the online calendar for scheduling) from 9:00AM until Noon at the Indoor Range. The cost is \$10 for the first child and

\$5 for each additional child (cash or checks are accepted). The program is open to both boys and girls, ages 8 to 20.
